Burt Myers Wins NASCAR Whelen Modified Championship with Roush Yates Power

Mooreville, NC (October 18, 2010) Roush Yates Engines captured their fourth championship title this month with Burt Myers winning the NASCAR Whelen Southern Modified Tour Championship on Thursday night at Charlotte Motor Speedway.

Myers, driver of the number 1 Ford, led all but one lap of the UNOH Southern Slam 150 at Charlotte Motor Speedway's quarter mile front stretch to take home the win and the championship. This is Myers' first NASCAR touring series championship in his fourth year running a Roush Yates powered engine.

"We had to have everything go our way, and it did," said Myers. "I was 41 points behind going in, and I knew that was going to be a big jump, but I also knew we at least had a shot. We just went in planning to do everything we could do and it just all worked out for us. We're blessed, I can say that."

This is not the first taste of success for the Walnut Cove, N.C. driver. Earlier in the year, Myers also won his fourth track title in the Modified Division at Bowman Gray Stadium and the NASCAR Whelen All-American Series North Carolina Championship.

"If you can believe Burt Myers is at a loss for words, I'm close," said Myers. "Bowman Gray champion, state champion, and tour champion – sounds pretty good to me!"

Recently, Roush Yates Engines has also won the 2010 TORC Off-Road Series Championship with Ricky Johnson, the 2010 Lucas Oil Late Model Dirt Series National Title with Scott Bloomquist, and the 2010 Sprint Cars of Dirt Championship with Ryan Grubbaugh.
